- Creating social media posts and managing social accounts, including responding to user comments and questions.
- Working with team members and community partners throughout the region sharing content ideas.
- Monitoring website and social media metrics.
- Lead the digital documentation of programs and events.

- You have experience in photography, digital design and crafting compelling messages.
- You have strong computer skills, are experienced using social media platforms and love capturing moments with photographs and video.
- You are a people person and connect with folks easily.

- You have a valid class 5 driver's license and a reliable vehicle with appropriate insurance.

Work Environment:
